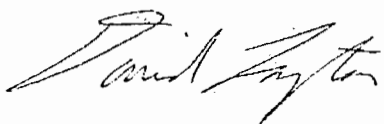

- i. referred to at the hearing of the appeal in this matter and not covered by a publication ban; or
 - ii. lawfully obtained by the appellant from a third-party source other than the Crown.

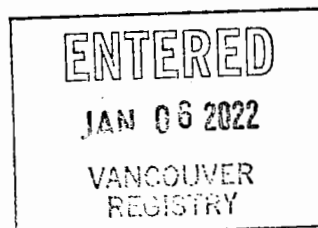
