Subject called the emergency line and advised that he called LNGLS last week as he is in ICE custody. I advised subject that in the future, he should be calling the inmate line between 8:30 to 10:30 a.m. and provided him the number.

Subject stated that in 2011 he completed the ppt application for removal from the U.S. and would like to know if he can submit the same form since he believes that he was born in the U.S. and he did not understand why Canada would issue a document to him when he is not a citizen of Canada. I advised him that a document would have been processed only if we had documentation to prove that he is a citizen of Canada. Subject claimed that there is someone else with the same name as him, but it is not him, if the U.S. government wants to pay for his trip to Canada and Canada wants to issue a document to the wrong person, he's fine with that and will not complain about it.

Subject complained that he spent 4 years in custody and then ICE bounced him around for awhile before he was released. He stated that his ex-wife complained to the authorities that he is a fugitive which caused him to be arrested last week. I stated to subject that since he was deported from the U.S., he is not supposed to be in the U.S. He balked and stated that he has a 12 year old son here and he will not stay away.

Subject stated that he was concerned that last time he completed the application; ICE did not submit it to LNGLS for 6 months. He then stated that "I guess I'll just have to sit around for 6 months again."
