Subject called LNGLS this morning. He stated that he had been thinking about our conversation yesterday afternoon and he does not want to continue to have problems with ICE and be bounced around for another 4 years because he has a life and a son that he was kept from during this time. Subject then asked if he were to fill out the ppt application with the info ICE and LNGLS believes to be of him, whether he would have issues in Canada. I asked him whether he wishes to know if there are any outstanding warrants for his arrest in Canada. He balked and stated that he knows there are no warrants for his arrest.

Subject stated that his contention is that it is not true what ICE and LNGLS believes that he was born in Canada. He advised that he is willing to speed the process along if all it takes is for him to state what ICE and LNGLS believe on the application, he will sign and declare it, but wondered if this will cause problems for him since this is exactly what he did for the travel document to be issued 15 months ago. I advised subject that in order for an ETD to be issued, security checks are performed and PPTC is aware of the application and whether an ETD can be issued. Subject continued on about it not making sense that he is making a false statement and declaration, but still is able to have a document issued. Advised subject that I am unable to continue to stay on the line with him discussing what he wishes to write or not write on the passport application as it is ultimately his decision.
